- Year 6 Students may participate in a second club if they are electing JWACS Touch Rugby Club, providing there are spaces available in their second club preference.

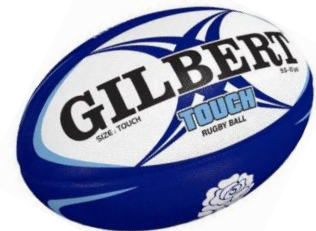

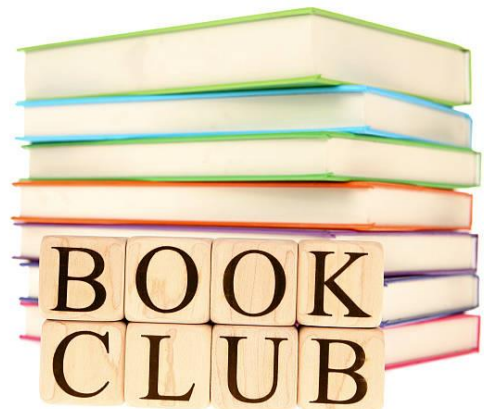
Book Club

Netball Club

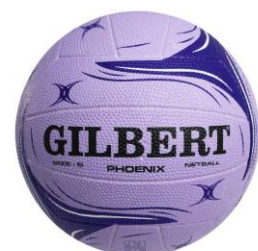
