Dear Parents and Carers

TERM 2 UPDATE

Further to my letter dated Tuesday 21 April, I write to you to provide further important information regarding the commencement of Term 2 on Wednesday 29 April. As previously advised, for the first three weeks of term (to Friday 15 May), all ASC schools will take a phased approach to return to normal operations.

As of this afternoon, 29% of students (Pre-K to 12) have advised they will be attending next Wednesday. Students will continue learning via the online program that was put in place for the final weeks of Term 1.

Students in Years 11 and 12 are strongly encouraged to return to school. At this stage, numbers attending in Year 12 will enable face-to-face delivery in ATAR classes. Students who do not attend will continue learning online. Importantly, we envisage a change to face-to-face lessons when the majority of students return to campus.

Winter Uniform

All students returning to the School campus are required to wear their full winter uniform. The Uniform Store will be open on Wednesday 29 April from 8:30am – 10:00am and 1:30pm – 3:30pm. Attendance and Transport Survey

In my previous correspondence we asked parents/carers to inform the School if they intended on sending their children to school for the start of Term 2 in order to allow us to effectively plan for the number of students on site. We respect each family's decision in this regard but do request that if your child is feeling unwell or showing any signs of illness, that you keep them at home. Students who present unwell will be sent home.

School Drop-off and Collection

We have developed specific requirements for drop-off and pick-up in order to maintain a safe environment for all families and staff which are outlined in detail below:

- Parents/Carers of students in Pre-Primary to Year 12 are reminded they are not to enter the school campus beyond the carpark or designated Kiss and Drop areas. Staff will be in attendance before and after school to assist students.
- Parents/Carers with children in Little Wollies and Kindergarten may escort their child to the classroom door before leaving immediately.
- Students arriving to school late or leaving early will be required to attend ELC Reception, Primary Reception or Student Services for signing in/out. Parents/Carers are advised to park their car in the nearest carpark and to call the relevant Reception (see numbers below) to sign their child in/out. Students leaving for the day will be escorted to the carpark by a staff member.
