- Students may select three (3) options, in order of preference. We will endeavour where possible to give students their first choice, however this is not always achievable. Students must choose 3 different clubs. If they choose the same Club for all 3 preferences, they will not be allocated to this Club.
- In Week 3, Teachers will inform the students and their families as to the Club the child is in for the term along with any other information about the Club.
