Note for Parents...

- ◆ Students are to be at their designated bus stop at least 5 minutes prior to bus arrival.
- ◆ For JWACS Bus Drivers only...please contact the bus driver via text message on the emergency bus mobile number given should your child be absent on any day so that the driver is aware and not waiting unnecessarily.
- ◆ If buses are loaded to capacity, no casual passengers will be carried.
- ◆ All permanent passengers MUST be registered to ensure your child's seat.
- ◆ Please ensure Registration Forms are returned to the Administration Office for processing.
- ◆ All enquiries regarding bus routes should be made to the School on 9495 8100.
- ◆ Please ensure that your child always provides his/her bus pass when asked to do so by the bus driver. (This only refers to the Buswest Buses: Routes 1/2, 3, 4, 5 & 6).

GENERAL BUS RULES

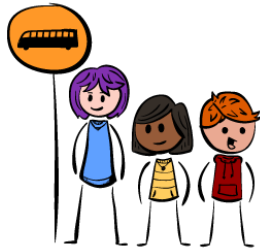
To ensure the safety of the driver and all passengers, the following rules apply:

Follow the bus driver's directions without argument

- * Bus drivers are to be treated with the same respect as School staff.

Respect other people and property

- * Treat other people and their possessions with respect.
- * Do not interfere with bus property, equipment, shelters or signs by marking or damaging them in any way.



Wait for the bus in an orderly manner

- * Wait well back from the bus until it stops and allow other passengers to leave the bus first.
- * Stand quietly without calling out or shouting.
- * Do not push other people in the line.

Students must, when on the bus:

- * Always follow instructions from the driver about safety on the bus.
- * If travelling on **BUSWEST, Routes 1/2, 3, 4, 5 or 6**; Students **MUST** show their bus pass / paid casual ticket upon entry onto a bus. (*JWACS Buses do not require a Bus Pass, only paid casual ticket for a once off trip*).
- * Primary students must be seated in seats at the front of the bus.
- * Sit properly on a seat if one is available (in an allocated seat if directed by the driver).
- * **Wear a seatbelt** (where fitted on the bus) for the duration of their journey.
- * If standing, remain in the area designated by the driver.
- * Store school bags under the seat or in appropriate luggage areas.
- * Conduct themselves in an orderly manner.
- * Immediately report to the bus driver any new damage noticed to bus fittings/fixtures. This includes graffiti.



Students must NOT:

- * Bully other students.
- * Place their feet on seats.
- * Damage or vandalise seating, windows, doors and/or other fittings and fixtures of the bus.
- * Use offensive language.
- * Throw any article around or from the bus.
- * Consume food or drink, or play music without permission of the driver.
- * Use mobile telephones on the bus.
- * Allow any part of their bodies to protrude out of the bus windows.
- * Stand forward of the front seat while the bus is in motion.

Use designated stops:

- * It is the responsibility of students to disembark at their correct designated stop.
