In Term 2, the successful applicant will work within our Year 7 Transition Program, a unique and supportive bridge between Primary and Secondary schooling. Students benefit from the consistency of a dedicated teacher for the majority of the day, while also experiencing the richness of specialist Secondary classes. Housed in our purpose-built Year 7 Centre, our four Year 7 classes enjoy a nurturing environment grounded in strong pastoral care and a robust academic framework. The role involves planning and delivering high-quality learning experiences across Mathematics, English, Science, and Humanities and Social Sciences, with planning support available.

In Term 3, the role transitions to a Year 6 class, working alongside a highly collaborative team of two other teachers.
