



## Casual Bus Drivers

### About the Role:

John Wollaston Anglican Community School (JWACS) is seeking flexible and reliable casual School Bus Drivers to support our student transport services during school terms. This is a casual position, with work available Monday to Friday during school terms only. The School operates daily morning and afternoon bus runs, and applicants must be flexible and available to work one or both shifts, depending on operational needs.

The usual shifts are:

- Morning shift: 6:00am – 8:30am
- Afternoon shift: 2:30pm – 5:00pm

There may also be opportunities to work additional daytime hours for school excursions or special trips, as required.

### Key Responsibilities:

The successful applicant will demonstrate the ability to:

- Actively support the Mission, Vision and Ethos and Core Values of AngliSchools and John Wollaston Anglican Community School.
- Actively support and promote a strong child safe culture.
- Work both independently and collaboratively as part of the School Operational Team.
- Apply effective problem-solving and technical troubleshooting skills, with a flexible and positive approach, particularly when working with students.
- Always ensure a clear duty of care to students, including during boarding, transit, and disembarkation, and act promptly to address any safety, wellbeing, or behaviour concerns.
- Apply well developed organisational and time management skills, ensuring routes and schedules are completed safely and punctually.
- Communicate clearly, confidently and respectfully with students, families and staff.
- Safely operate a school bus in accordance with all road rules, transport regulations and School policies and procedures.

Applicants must hold or be willing to obtain:

- A current Medium Rigid (MR) driver's licence.
- A current Passenger Transport Driver (PTD) Authorisation.
- A valid Working with Children (WWC) Check.
- A Nationally Coordinated Criminal History Check (NCCHC) dated within the last three months)
- A current First Aid certificate.
