The successful applicant will provide leave cover for two staff members, teaching one Kindergarten class during Term 3 before transitioning to a different Kindergarten class in Term 4. This role offers the opportunity to work within a collaborative and supportive Early Learning environment committed to high-quality early childhood education.

Key Responsibilities:

- Implement and deliver engaging, age-appropriate learning experiences using established programs aligned with the Western Australian Curriculum, Early Years Learning Framework (EYLF), Kindergarten Curriculum Guidelines, and the International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme (PYP) philosophy.
- Support a strong philosophical alignment with play-based pedagogy.
- Maintain clear, detailed and timely records of student achievement and development, and communicate effectively with parents and guardians to support student learning and wellbeing.
- Uphold the school's value, policies and procedures to create a safe, inclusive and nurturing learning environment.

- You hold a recognised Early Childhood teaching qualification and demonstrate an excellent understanding of early childhood development.
- You bring a warm, nurturing and child-centred approach to teaching, fostering positive learning experiences for young children.
- You have strong communication and interpersonal skills, enabling you to build respectful, collaborative relationships with students, families and colleagues.
- You are highly organised, adaptable and responsive to the dynamic needs of early learners and a busy learning environment.

- You have a valid Working with Children Check or are willing to obtain.
