## **DIGITAL SAFETY AND STUDENT IMAGES**

As part of our commitment to child safety and privacy, JWACS has invested in the secure Pixevety platform for the management, storage and sharing of school photographs of students. Pixevety supports the School in:

- Protecting student digital images
- Supporting accurate photo permissions management
- Reducing the risk of unauthorised image sharing.

The platform assists the School in maintaining safe, responsible and privacy-conscious management of student images while supporting community connection and celebration of School life.
